

## 16th Bosch Global Supplier Award Award-winners 2019

### The award

The supplier of technology and services Bosch has presented 47 suppliers with its “Bosch Global Supplier Award.” This is the 16th time the Bosch Group has rewarded outstanding performance in the manufacture and supply of products and services, and makes the award-winners the pick of the roughly 43,000 companies that supply goods and services to Bosch. They come from Europe (28), 19 of those from Germany, North America (5), and Asia Pacific (14). Bosch has conferred awards in a total of four categories: purchasing and indirect materials, raw materials and components, purchasing of direct materials (broken down by business sector), and innovation. The theme of this year’s award ceremony was “Transforming Together. Staying Ahead.”

The majority of voting rights are held by Robert Bosch Industrietreuhand KG, an industrial trust. The entrepreneurial ownership functions are carried out by the trust. The remaining shares are held by the Bosch family and by Robert Bosch GmbH.*
