Dr. Stefan Assmann has been the business chief digital officer of Bosch's Industrial Technology business sector since July 1, 2019. In this function, he is responsible for the digital transformation and digitalization of the business sector's operating units. Previously, Assmann was head of the newly established Bosch Connected Industry unit, where Bosch pools its expertise to develop Industry 4.0 solutions for external customers as well as for its own plants. Prior to this, he held numerous other positions within the Bosch Group, including head of the business unit for assembly systems and special-purpose machinery as well as plant manager in Germany and abroad.

Stefan Assmann was born on February 19, 1964, in Bonn, Germany. After completing secondary school in 1983, he studied electrical engineering at RWTH Aachen, and took his diploma examination in 1990. He then worked as a research associate in the Laboratory for Machine Tools and Production Engineering (WZL) at RWTH Aachen, before obtaining his doctorate in mechanical engineering in 1996.
