Henning von Boxberg appointed as new President of Bosch Service Solutions

- ▶ President Dr. Jörg Fischer is to retire on December 31

Frankfurt am Main – Henning von Boxberg will become President of Bosch Service Solutions GmbH with effect from January 1, 2019. He is taking over this position from Dr. Jörg Fischer, who retires at the end of 2018.

In his future position at Bosch Service Solutions, Henning von Boxberg will continue to drive the handling of business processes, the so-called business process outsourcing, with innovative service solutions in the areas of mobility, monitoring and customer experience. In early 2009, he assumed responsibility for sales of power tools in Europe, the Middle East and Africa. He has been a member of the Board of Bosch Power Tools GmbH since 2011. He took over as president in 2013.
