Compared to existing batteries in the Bosch range, such as the GBA 18V 4.0Ah Professional, the temporary maximum power has been doubled. The EXBA18V-80 and EXBA18V-150 models even deliver up to 2,400 watts of temporary maximum power. This raises the performance level to the next stage and thus lays the foundation for the exceptional performance of the new Expert devices.

From January 2026, the first 30 Expert power tools and measuring devices will be available. A highlight is the world's first gasless cordless stapler, the [EXPERT EXTH18V-50M](#), which offers the full power of a pneumatic tool – without the effort and cost associated with compressors, hoses, and gas cartridges. Another highlight is the [EXPERT EXSA18V-32](#) reciprocating saw, which is not only powerful but also the first reciprocating saw to feature KickBack Control that immediately stops the tool if the saw blade jams, not only minimizing the risk of injury but also preventing the bending or even breaking of saw blades. In the field of measuring technology, Bosch presents the innovative wall scanner [EXPERT D-tect18V-200-17C](#). This supports professional users in precisely locating objects in many different wall types. For the first time, innovative Bosch radar technology is used in combination with AI object detection.
