In the motor vehicle parts supplier category, Bosch leads in all nine reputation attributes: innovation, people management, use of corporate assets, social responsibility, quality of management, financial soundness, long-term investment value, quality of products and services, and global competitiveness.

In *Fortune*'s Global 500 list, Bosch ranks among the top 100 companies, having moved up to 87 in 2017 from 150 in 2016.
